- 3 (i) The provisions of §§ 15-105, 15-112, 15-113, 15-804, [and] 15-812, AND 4 15-826 of the Insurance Article shall apply to health maintenance organizations.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall apply to all new plans, policies, or contracts issued or delivered or renewed in the State on or after January 1, 1999, and to the renewal of all plans, policies, or contracts in effect before January 1, 1999, except that any plan, policy, or contract in effect before January 1, 1999 shall comply with the provisions of this Act no later than July 1, 10 4999.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 12 July 1, 1998.
