After the search strategy is developed, select the **Save this search** button towards the top right of the screen.

To retrieve your saved search, select the **View saved searches** button towards the top right of the screen.

e-mail alert Load Append Share Export Delete

- **Load** will rerun the search and overwrite any search lines that are currently on the search screen.
- **Append** will add the saved search beneath any search lines that are currently on the search screen.
- **Share** will allow you to copy a URL that will link to the saved search, or to send a link to the saved search via email.
- **Export** will save the search strategy as a text file.
- **Delete** is for removing any saved search strategies.

Check the **e-mail alert** box next to a search name to receive a notification of any new results that are added to the Cochrane Library and match the search criteria.
